There is no obligation to make a tax-deductible contribution to enter, but we hope you will respond generously. You need not be present to win; the lucky winners will be notified and will have one week to acknowledge their acceptance.

Prizes need to be claimed before June 4, 2012; the winner is responsible for collecting the prize or arranging for shipment. Prizes are not redeemable for cash, and substitution of prizes is not possible.

Any taxes on prizes are the full responsibility of the prize winners. The IRS requires the Museum to withhold at the rate of 28% for prizes exceeding \$5,000.

Employees of the Museum and their families are not eligible for the Give the Arts a Chance 2012 benefit drawing.


C O N T E M P O R A R Y C R A F T S M A N S H I P

JEWELRY SPREE




